I am just eternally grateful, as is she, that she has the privilege to be a part of your school family.

I am so sad for you that you did not get the judgement you truly deserve! Your school is amazing and we are really thankful the girls are part of your school. The hard work, determination, care and support that the staff in your school give daily is incredible. Our girls are lucky to attend a school where the whole child is valued and it was this focus, not your excellent results that set you apart from other schools. With that said, all of the teachers who have worked with our girls have been amazing at their job and I wanted to extend our thanks to them all, especially the Maths department who may be feeling a little bruised. Girls do not take Maths for A Level through chance and it is the teaching at your school which inspired my daughter to do so.

My congratulations to Mr Lester and his fabulous team for a really positive report. I know that Folkestone School for Girls is a remarkable school and environment where all flourish. Everyone should be immensely proud.

I felt compelled to write to you and your staff after receiving your email with regards to the recent OFSTED report and inspection at FSG.

My daughter is in Year 8 and is currently participating in the Cadet camp. The opportunities and experiences she has encountered since her relatively short time at FSG have been outstanding. She is challenged daily academically (including in set one mathematics) and the progress she is making is evident within her work.

As a parent your visibility at FSG is appreciated - I have only encountered the Head teacher at my sons school once, during their open day! My daughter has also mentioned how you chat to her during lunchtime clubs and at the various challenge days she has participated in.

Thank you to you and your staff for the invaluable effort you put into education on a daily basis and what may, sometimes, seem like a thankless task. Taking on the challenge of educating teenage girls should be commended!

As a parent I could not ask for anything more for my daughter. Your school has exceeded our expectations in all areas and I hope that you and your team really do not give Ofsted a second thought.

Like you, I am disappointed in the grade you received from OFSTED. As you say it is a tick box activity and I don't believe the results are worth paying much attention towards. They clearly don't have an understanding of what holistic education looks like. What you and your staff have done to support my child educationally & pastorally is worth more than an outstanding! I can't thank you enough for all you have done for my daughter and I will continue to tell everyone how great I think you are as a school. Thank you for all you have done and continue to do.

I have just had sight of the Ofsted report and quite frankly, a snapshot view over a couple of days does not reflect the exceptional school that FSG is.

In my Ofsted parent survey, I highlighted your dedication to the girls as well as that of the teachers. I also flagged that FSG is an exceptional school. As far as I am concerned, a report stating "good" does not change my view of the fantastic job that you all do. My daughter is happy and thriving and is very much looking forward to their big performance at the National Theatre soon.

Keep doing what you are doing, it is appreciated and "outstanding".

We pupils and parents know the school is outstanding.

We really appreciate all the hard work that you and your team put into the FSGBacc. My daughter has had a lot of fun doing radio and continues to get so much from cadets. Just the other day she remarked that she enjoys Fridays a lot more knowing she has cadets after school!

I just wanted to show my support to you all at FSG.

You may not be 'outstanding' in the eyes of Ofsted, but FSG is not just a school - it's a community, a family, an army, raising some outstanding students by some outstanding teachers and outstanding opportunities.

There is no box to tick to say that a kind SDL personally called me to say how proud they were of my daughter when she stood up and delivered a presentation for her EPQ. There is no box to tick to say that a teacher recognised my daughter struggled with a particular subject, but appreciated and how hard she tried and how she took part and made the class a happier place. There is no box to tick for the teacher who was visibly upset when she realised she wouldn't be in school for her class's last A-Level exam. There is no box to tick for the head teacher who shows up on DofE expeditions, cycling around the countryside to check on the welfare of his students. There is no box to tick for the kind form tutor who takes time to provide little gifts and encouraging notes at the end of term or before exams for all her class. And I could go on...

Thank you to ALL of the staff at FSG - I am incredibly grateful for what you do everyday, which is simply immeasurable by Ofsted or anyone else.
